



## Norman K. Snyder Jr.

February 21, 1963 - June 12, 2014

Norman Kenneth Snyder, Jr., of Easton, MD, died unexpectedly on June 12, 2014, at the University of MD Shore Medical Center in Easton. He was 51.

Born on February 21, 1963, he was the son of the late Norman Kenneth Snyder, Sr., and the late Pauline Louise Lomax Davis.

Mr. Snyder lived all his life in Maryland, the majority on the Eastern Shore. He was a 1981 graduate of Easton High School. He is best known as “Norm Elliott” News Director at the four radio stations of the MTS Broadcasting Group, leaving in 2006. Since 2007 he was a lieutenant at the Talbot County Dept. of Emergency Services 911 Division. He was named “Dispatcher of the Year” in 2013 by MD State Numbers Board Association.

Norm is survived by his wife of almost 20 years, Patricia Lankford Snyder; a brother, Robert Russell Snyder and his wife Roxanne and their children, Joshua and Riley Snyder of Cabot, AR. He is also survived by a brother-in-law, Lloyd Lankford and his wife Barbara of Easton; brother-in-law, Robert Lankford and his wife Debbie of Easton; sister-in-law, Linda Wagner and her husband Carl of Wye Mills; and numerous nieces, nephews, and cousins.

A funeral service will be held on Tuesday, June 17, 2014, at 11 a.m. at the Easton Church of God. A visitation will be held one hour prior. Burial will be at

Woodlawn Memorial Park.
