Norman Edmund Peterson, Jr. of Easton, died at his home on Saturday, May 28, 2005. He was 69.

Born in Camden, New Jersey on September 30, 1935 he was the son of the late Norman E. and Edith Kartlai Peterson. Following his graduation from public school in Prince George's Co. Md. he attended the University of Maryland College Park where he received a Bachelor of Science degree in Engineering in 1959. In 1960 he began a career with N.A.S.A. at the Goddard Spaceflight Center in Greenbelt, Md., as an Aerospace Engineer where he remained until his retirement in the mid 1990's. He then continued to work as a consultant for private space flight companies until 2004. While at N.A.S.A he and his wife the former Charlene Briggs, whom he married on August 26, 1961 made their home in Calvert Co. until moving to Easton in 2004

Mr. Peterson was a former member of the Sigma- Chi fraternity, he also enjoyed traveling both for business and recreation and woodworking.

In addition to his wife Mr. Peterson is survived by two sons; James C. Peterson, and his wife Cassandra of Severn, Md., Thomas E. Peterson, and his wife Anne of Annapolis. Md. one sister, Miriam Carlson of Laurel, Md. and one brother Harold Peterson of Delaware, and four grandchildren, Sonya,

Stephen, Devin and Shelby.
