Norman Victor Filbert passed away on Sunday, March 23, 2008 at Deers Head Hospice. He was 79 years old.

Born on April 25, 1928 to the late Roy Filbert and Myrtle Richardson in Catonsville, MD, Norman joined the Marine Corp after graduating from high school. He served during WWII before being honorably discharged and returning to Maryland. Norman began working as a self-employed Brick and Stone Mason in the Baltimore area. In the early 1970s, he moved to Kent Island and continued his career as a Brick and Stone Mason. In 1968 he married Joanne Nothey.

Mr. Filbert has a patent on “shell-bond marine products.” He also was an aviation pilot and enjoyed painting and drawing. He was a member of the Kent Island United Methodist Church.

Norman Filbert is survived by his daughter, Eve A. Casey and her husband John of Bethesda, MD; son, Adam Filbert and his wife Andrea of Katy, TX; 3 grandchildren, Ashley E.
