Norris E. "Ned" Shannahan, Jr., 37, passed away at his home in Salisbury, MD, on Monday, November 8, 2021. He was born in Annapolis on August 24, 1984. He is the son of Norris "Chirp" Shannahan and K. MaGale Shannahan.

He grew up in Oxford on Boone Creek where he enjoyed boating, crabbing, and fishing. He was a competitive ice hockey player from the age of 6 through high school and was very active in local ice hockey travel teams.
