Betty Olive Plugge of Church Hill, MD, died on October 7, 2015, at Corsica Hills Nursing Home. She was 79.

Born on the family farm in Ruthsburg, MD, she was the daughter of the late James Oscar Sparks and Bernice Morris Everngam. Olive was a graduate of Centreville High School, and worked in various jobs, including being a seamstress, cleaning homes, working at the Tidewater Bank. She belonged to St. Paul's United Methodist Church in Ingleside, where she also taught Sunday school in the 1970s. In her spare time, Olive enjoyed clipping newspapers.

She is survived by her children: Beverly, Frank, Jr., Louis and John; brothers, Alvin and Kenny Sparks; five grandchildren; and 12 great-grandchildren. She was preceded in death in 2005 by her daughter, Marleen.

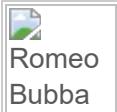
