



Ollie Marian Miller

October 23, 1930 - February 11, 2015

Ollie Marian Miller of Easton, MD, peacefully joined her Lord and Savior on Wednesday, February 11, 2015, at Talbot Hospice House in Easton. She was 84.

Marian was born near Preston in Caroline County on October 23, 1930, to Ollie and Pearl Andrew Carpenter.

In 1950, she married the late Herbert R. Bradley. In 1979, she married the late Raymond M. Miller.

One of Marian's deepest desires was to work with children. She worked as an instructional assistant for Talbot County Public Schools for 27 years. After retiring, she continued her life's work as a full-time volunteer. Volunteering to help others was her passion. She amassed an impressive 18,500 hours with the hospital auxiliary; 2,630 hours at the Talbot Hospice House; and spent eight years at Chapel District Elementary helping students read. She also volunteered with Perry Point Veterans Hospital, the former William Hill Manor, the Waterfowl Festival, and the Pines.

In addition to her extensive volunteerism, Marian was involved in the Talbot County Women's Club, the VFW Auxiliary, American Legion Auxiliary, and the Elks Lodge Auxiliary. She was a lifetime member of Christ Church in Easton

where she helped with the church sale and altar guild, and taught Sunday school classes.

Marian is survived by her daughters, Nancy Bradley, Cynthia Doupnik, Carol (Jeff) Shores, and Kim Bradley; five grandchildren, Missy Hollis, Justin Eason, Cara Doupnik, Jacob Shores, and Savannah Shores; and five great-grandchildren, Lauren and Meredith Rose, Tanner Hollis, and Tucker and Ma'Kaila Eason.

A memorial service will be held on Saturday, February 21, 2015, at 2 p.m. at St. Mark's United Methodist Church in Easton.
