Ora Harden Seymour, 101, of Trappe, MD, died on Tuesday, November 11, 2014, at Candlelight Cove in Easton, MD. She was born in Trappe on October 23, 1913, daughter of the late Robert Lee Griffin and Mary Abbie Sullivan Griffin.

Mrs. Seymour graduated from Trappe High School. She was the last survivor of seven in the Class of 1931. She was employed as a cashier for H & G Restaurant in Easton for nearly 30 years.

She is survived by a daughter-in-law, Patricia S. Harden of Trappe; two grandchildren, Diane H. Tecotzky and Karen M. Harden; and five great-grandchildren, Amy L. Dorsch, Kristen L. Dorsch, Brian D.
