



## O. Rayfield Tarr

Oscar Rayfield Tarr of Centreville, MD died at the Corsica Hills Nursing Home, Centreville on Friday, August 6, 2004. He was 99.

Born March 6, 1905 near Starr, MD, he was the son of the late Oscar W. and Carrie O. Davis Tarr. On December 24, 1925 he married the former Sadie Embert of Starr, MD. He farmed until 1968 when he then was employed by the Queen Anne's County Sheriff Office for 6 years. He then worked for S.E.W. Friel & Co. in Queenstown until he was 96 years old. Mr. & Mrs. Tarr were married 65 years when Mrs. Tarr died on February 26, 1990.

He was a member of the Centreville United Methodist Church where he was very active in many positions. He was also active in the Centreville Ruritan Club and was past president of the Centreville Southern States Cooperative. He will be remembered for selling many, many tickets for chicken dinners for both the Centreville United Methodist Church and the Goodwill Volunteer Fire Company.

Mr. Tarr is survived by a son, Robert H. Tarr and his wife, Charlotte of Greenwood, DE; a daughter-in-law, Maudie Tarr and her family, of Rolla, Missouri; three grandchildren, Theresa Lynne Corder of Greenwood, DE, Brian Jay Tarr of Hacks Point, MD and Deborah Tarr of Missouri and four great grandchildren, Darian Corder and Brooke Corder, both of Greenwood,

DE and Emory Tarr and Ethan Tarr, both of Hacks Point, MD.

He was pre-deceased by two sons, James Dudley Tarr and O. Rayfield Tarr, Jr.; a brother, Richard S. Tarr and a sister, Margaret Jones Barton.
