



## Oscar Carlson, Jr.

July 3, 1929 - July 1, 2011

Oscar W. Carlson, Jr., 81 beloved husband, father, grandfather, and friend, died at home July 1, 2011.

Oscar was born July 3, 1929, in McKeesport, PA, to the Rev. Oscar W. Carlson, Sr. and Mary Thomas Carlson. He is survived by his wife, Carol; children, Oscar W. Carlson, III, and Caroline Carlson Maisel; son-in-law, Stephen J. Maisel, Jr.; grandchildren, Jacob Maisel and Mary Maisel; sister, Harriett Edwards and Mary Ruos; and many nieces and nephews.

Oscar was a graduate of the Gilman School, Baltimore, MD, and Haverford College, Haverford, PA. He served in the US Army during the Korean Conflict.

He worked at the Budd Company, McCormick & Company, and for 35 years was a stockbroker at Merrill Lynch working in the Baltimore, Columbia, and Easton offices. He opened the Columbia and Easton offices for the firm. In his retirement, Oscar served as an arbitrator for the Financial Industry Regulatory Authority.

Oscar lived in Baltimore, Elliott City, St. Michaels, and Easton.

He was a member of Ascension Lutheran Church, Towson, MD, which his father founded, St. John's Episcopal Church, Ellicott City and Christ Episcopal Church, St. Michaels. Oscar was an active member in his community and

believed in giving back to others. He was an active Rotarian and served on the boards of the Howard County General Hospital, Linwood Children's Center, Commercial and Farmers Bank, For All Seasons, Londonderry Retirement Community, the Dixon House, the Mid-Shore Mental Health Association, the St. Michaels Community Center, and the Talbot County Library Foundation. He mentored students in Talbot County, was a member of the Board of Managers of the Episcopal Diocese of Easton, the Mid-Shore League of Women Voters, and the vestries of St. John's and Christ Church.

He was a loving, generous, and faithful man who is missed dearly by his family and friends. A funeral will be held, Friday, July 8, 2011, at 11:00 am at Christ Church St. Michaels.
