Oscar W. Moeller of Easton, MD, died on Monday, February 4, 2008, at Genesis Healthcare-The Pines, Easton. He was 83.

Born February 28, 1924, in Baltimore, MD, he was the son of the late Oscar J. and Minna K. Heil Moeller. During World War II, he served in the U.S. Army in Europe and was part of the 22nd Infantry Regiment 4th Infantry Division who landed in Normandy on D-Day. After moving to Easton, MD, in 1950, he worked for Waverly Press until retiring after 36 years of service. Following retirement, he did cabinet work for the Bartley Collection.

A member of Sts. Peter & Paul Catholic Church in Easton, he was also a member of the Easton Lions Club, E.E. Streets Memorial Post 5118 V.F.W., and a life member of B.P.O. Easton Elks Lodge #1622.

Mr. Moeller is survived by his wife, the former Mary Ripken, whom he married July 7, 1946; three children, Mary Katherine Brotman (Dennis) of Palm Harbor, FL, Frances Phillips (Hank) of Easton, and Theresa Rainey (Randy) of Cape St. Claire; six grandchildren; and five great-grandchildren.
