Osmar “Ozzie” Guido Hebert died Sunday, November 24, 2002 at his home in Centreville. He was 67.

A native of Baltimore, Mr. Hebert was graduated from Towson Senior High School. He earned a B.S. in forestry at Purdue University in 1958 and began work for the Maryland Department of Forests and Parks that year. In 1961 he was named District Park Supervisor for northern Maryland, charged with park operations, planning, and land acquisition. He became Chief for Resource Protection for Maryland in 1968, serving as administrator of the state-wide Forest Protection Program. In 1983 he became Boating Liaison Officer for the state, regulating recreational boating and resource management for the Chesapeake Bay. He retired July 1, 1988.

Mr. Hebert drove the bus for the Department of Aging in Queen Anne’s County and ran the Old Mill in Wye Mills MD after he retired.

A member of the Bay Country Moose Lodge, the Kent Island Yacht Club, and the Chesapeake Commodores’ Club, Mr. Hebert served as Commodore at Kent Island Yacht Club in 1975.

Mr. Hebert was the son of Osmar Alfred and Emma Ulrich Hebert of Baltimore, both deceased. He is survived by his wife, Mary Ellen; his son

Dean, of Owings, MD; his son, Eric and granddaughters, Amanda and Melissa, of Gainesville, FL; and his daughter, Heather Hewitt and grandson, Jason Seixas, of Ann Arbor, MI.
