Pamela Nelson Gannon, 74, died on Friday, June 1, 2018, at the University of Maryland Shore Medical Center in Easton. She was born in Centreville, MD, on July 18, 1943, the middle child of James Luther and Permelia Dadds Nelson.

She was pre-deceased by her husband, Thomas Nathaniel Gannon, in July 1999. They were married for 32 years and owned a successful general contracting business, Gannon & Sons, Inc., as well as Centreville Lumber Company. Active in the local business community, they were long-term members of Our Mother of Sorrows Catholic Parish in Centreville.

Pam graduated from Centreville High School, Class of 1961, where she was active in sports, and worked as a bookkeeper at Centreville National Bank until she got married and started a family. She kept the books for her husband's business for a number of years and was also a long-time member of the Queen Anne's County Garden Club. She enjoyed traveling and watching old movies.
