



Pamela Weatherby Rhodes

June 16, 1946 - June 4, 2024

Pamela Weatherby Rhodes of Chestertown, MD passed away peacefully at home, surrounded by her family, on June 4, 2024. She was 77 years old.

Pam was born in Philadelphia, PA on June 16, 1946, the daughter of the late Doris E. Hill and John W. Weatherby. She graduated from Moorestown Friends School in Moorestown, NJ with the class of 1965. When she was 19 years old, she met who would later become her husband of over 50 years, Thomas Rhodes. They were introduced to each other by their younger brothers, who attended school together, and by July of 1972 they were married.

Pam was primarily a homemaker; however, she has always been very active in her community. She and Tom were members of the Cooper River Yacht Club, where Pam worked on the race committee while Tom and their sons raced. Once they moved to Chestertown, they both were the race committee for the Rock Hall Friday Night Racing Series. Pam also volunteered at the Church Hill Theatre where she worked on constructing and painting sets for multiple plays and musicals. She was particularly fond of participating in the Theatre's Green Room Gang summer children's acting workshop. She joined Tom on his travels across the U.S. for work, even travelling as far as Hawaii together. They also enjoyed renovating homes together. She was Tom's right-hand woman, able to hold her own when doing carpentry, electrical work, and

anything else she set her mind to. Pam and Tom were instrumental in the building and design of Zelda's Speakeasy in Chestertown - the iconic zebra wallpaper is all courtesy of Pam.

In addition to her husband, Thomas Rhodes, she is survived by her sons, Reese Rhodes and Stephen Rhodes; grandchildren: Nicole Rhodes, Michael Rhodes, Ashley Rhodes, and Leila Rhodes; brother, Stephen Weatherby; and sister, Carol Weatherby.
