



## Miss. Patricia Ann Campbell

April 2, 1941 - June 3, 2013

Patricia Ann Campbell of Rock Hall, MD died on Monday, June 3, 2013 at her home. She was 72.

Born on April 2, 1941 in Darby, PA, she was the daughter of the late, Joseph A. Campbell, Sr. and Eleanora Fiore Campbell. Miss Campbell graduated from Queen of Angels Catholic School in Haddonfield, NJ, Class of 1958. She went to work for Harleysville Mutual Insurance Company in Haddonfield, NJ, starting as a file clerk and working her way up to an Insurance Intermediary between the company and their agents. She retired in the mid 1990's. She also worked part time at Bamberger's Department Store with her mother for a few years. Miss Campbell moved from New Jersey to Rock Hall prior to her retirement.

She attended St. John's Catholic Church in Rock Hall. Miss Campbell was a past member of Chestertown Elks Lodge # 2474. Miss Campbell volunteered at Chester River Hospital Center. She was also a participant in a Wednesday night supper club with some friends. Miss Campbell enjoyed bingo, bowling, fishing, spending time on the Chesapeake Bay, and spending time with her family.

She is survived by a brother, Joseph A. Campbell, Jr. and wife, Lori of Rock Hall, MD; a niece, Jennifer Campbell of Haddonfield, NJ; a nephew, Edwin
