



Patricia Maxine Dillingham

July 21, 1932 - June 15, 2024

Patricia Maxine Dillingham of Rock Hall, MD died on June 15th at her home. She was 91.

She was born in Washington D.C. on July 21, 1932, the daughter of the late Gerard C. and Jessie M. (Elliott)Murphy.

Pat was a graduate of Thayer Business College in Washington D.C. and worked with Akel and Coe Brokerage and later the National Security Agency in Washington and later Ft. Meade, MD serving a total of three years. She then worked briefly with a commercial real estate firm in Washington before her marriage to Paul “Pete” Dillingham, Jr. in 1959.

Mrs. Dillingham raised her family and wouldn't rejoin the workforce until later when she had an opportunity to co-own and operate The King Carter Inn in Irvington, Va. She ran the inn for another three years before moving to Rock Hall, MD.

On the Eastern Shore she became active in her community, serving on the Altar Guild at her beloved St. Paul's Kent Episcopal Church, as Co-President of the League of Woman Voters, President of the Woman's League of Washington College, a member of the 1782 Club, active with the Lifelong Learning Program at Washington College, and a member of the Cadwalladers of Kent Questors where she served as President. She also served as President of the Maryland Questors during which time she oversaw the National Questors Convention in Baltimore.

She loved Local and State history and architecture. She also enjoyed

gardening, reading, travel, visiting national parks, entertaining with her excellent cooking and storytelling, and was an excellent bowler in her younger years. She was a devoted wife, mother, grandmother, and friend.

In addition to her husband, she is survived by her sons: Timothy P. Dillingham (Barbara) and Paul W. Dillingham, III, (Rosemary) and her grandchildren: Catherine, Leah, David, Patrick, Grace, and Paul W. Dillingham IV.

Services will be held on Wednesday, June 19, 2024, at 2:00 PM at St. Paul's Episcopal Church in Chestertown. Interment will follow in the churchyard. A visitation will be held on Wednesday June 19th at Fellows, Helfenbein, and Newnam Funeral Home 130 Speer Rd Chestertown from 12:00-1:30PM.
