Patricia D. Guschke of St. Michaels, MD died on Saturday, June 28, 2008 at Talbot Hospice House, Easton. She was 80.

Born on March 17, 1928 in Crisfield, MD, she was the daughter of the late, Clifford C. and Emma Cox Daugherty. She attended Crisfield High School, graduating Class of 1946. She continued her education, graduating from James Madison University in 1950 and attending post graduate school at Vanderbilt University where she then worked as an administrative dietitian. From 1954 to 1966 Mrs. Guschke worked at Memorial Hospital at Easton where she was their first dietitian. In 1972, she began working as an administrative dietitian with the Department of Mental Health and Hygiene throughout the State of Maryland. She retired in 1986.

On April 14, 1952, she married Joseph E. Guschke and they resided in Nashville, TN, moving to St. Michael's in 1954. Due to her husband's career, she and her family resided in Baltimore, Harford County and Anne Arundel County between the years of 1966 and 1986. They returned to St. Michaels in 1986.

Mrs. Guschke was a member of the American Dietetic Association.

In addition to her husband, Mrs. Guschke is survived by four children, Joseph

Guschke, Jr. and his wife, Darlene, James Bradford Guschke, Stephen Guschke and Sean Guschke and his wife, Holley; a brother, Wendell J. Daugherty and his wife, Mildred of Salisbury; three grandchildren, Joseph Guschke, III, Mary Guschke and James Guschke, Jr.; niece, Kay Andrew; and special niece, Betty Sue Kilmon and her husband, Joseph.
