



## Patricia Dilworth Hodil

December 7, 1933 - September 22, 2014

Patricia Fern Dilworth Hodil of Stevensville, MD, passed away peacefully September 22, 2014, at Anne Arundel Medical Center. She was 80 years old.

Mrs. Hodil was born December 7, 1933, in Monroe, LA, to the late Benjamin Fitzgerald Dilworth and Fern Elizabeth Conroy Dilworth. She attended schools in Mississippi and graduated from Miller-Hawkins Business College, Memphis, TN. There she met her devoted husband of 57 years, Earl Humes Hodil. They were married February 24, 1957.

After working at Mississippi State University as a secretary, the family moved to Kent Island in MD where Mrs. Hodil raised her three children and was involved with their various activities.

Later she would resume working at Chesapeake College for 20 years, retiring in 1994. She obtained her Associate of Arts degree and was named in Who's Who of American Colleges and Universities, of which she was very proud. She was a member of the Mary Circle of Kent Island United Methodist Church and a faithful choir member for many years.

In addition to her beloved husband, she is survived by three children, Earl Dilworth Hodil and his wife Cathi, of Longwood, FL, Elizabeth Jean Hodil Covington and her husband Henry, of Centreville, MD, and David Edward
