



Patricia Nash Hoxter

March 12, 1942 - June 13, 2018

Patricia Nash Hoxter of Smyrna, DE, passed away at her home on June 13, 2018. She was 76.

Born on March 12, 1942, in Chester, MD, she was the daughter of the late Florence (Baxter) and John Edward Nash, Sr. Patricia graduated from Stevensville High School, Class of 1960 and would marry James Edward Hoxter on December 4, 1960. They resided in Grasonville where they raised their two children, and Pat was a homemaker and seamstress until they were in school. She then began working as a customer service representative at Miles & Stockbridge law firm and later went on to Piper & Mulberry; Betty Satchel Accountants, and finally to Legg Mason which became Smith Barney and later Morgan Stanley.

Pat retired in 2007, and then moved with Ed to Delaware to be close to their daughter. She belonged to three quilting guilds Helping Hands and Quilting for Others both in Dover, DE, and School House Quilt Guild in Middletown, DE. Along with quilting she loved to paint and was a member of St. Peter's Episcopal Church in Smyrna, DE, and St. Luke's Episcopal Church in Queenstown, MD.

Pat is survived by her husband Ed Hoxter, Sr.; daughter, Karla Radford (Bill) of Smyrna, DE; granddaughters Kayla Radford and Sydney Radford; brother,

Stewart Nash (Barbara) of Stevensville, MD; sisters, Joan Coleman (Joseph) of Chester, MD, and Kay Maloney (Edward) of Chester, MD. She was predeceased by her son, James Edward Hoxter, Jr.
