March 26, 1942 - October 27, 2024

Patricia Ann Hunter of Crumpton, passed away on 10/27/2024 in Christina, DE.

Patsy was born on March 26, 1942, to William Magee Sr. and Viola "Cohey" Magee. She graduated with the class of 1956 from Sudlersville High School. Following her graduation, she worked at Sears until it shut down. When Patsy welcomed her daughter, she took great pride in nurturing her and witnessing her growth. For several years, she babysat until the early 2000s, when she began working as a bookkeeper for Dixon Furniture Auction.

Patsy had been a dedicated member of the Crumpton Fire Company since 1983 and joined the Ladies Auxiliary in 1984. In 1985, she became a first responder and an EMT, followed by her certification in Pumps in 1997. From 2000 to 2004, she served as the Fire Department President and held the position of EMS Captain for 15 to 20 years. Notably, Patsy was the first female President of the Kent & Queen Anne's Fire Association and was inducted into their Hall of Fame in 1991. In addition to her presidential duties, she also fulfilled various roles including the ways & means committee, assistant treasurer, kitchen chair, and served on the nominating committee and board of directors in 2011/2012. Patsy found joy in playing bingo and board games, and in her younger years, dancing was a highlight of her life. She also took pleasure in showcasing her 1957 Chevy and 1956 Ford at different car shows.

In addition to her parents, she is preceded by her husband William E. Hunter, and her sister Betty Marie Ball.

Patsy is survived by her daughter, Tricia Lynn Hunter of Crumpton; her brother, William R. Magee Jr. of Georgia; and three grandchildren: Scott Mathew Turner of Crumpton, Kristin N. Deems (Josh) of Conowingo, and Douglas J. Riordan (Amanda) of Denton. She is also remembered fondly by her beloved pet, Boots.

There will be a visitation on Sunday, November 3rd at Fellows Family Funeral Home in Millington MD, from 12pm to 2 pm with a service to follow at 2. Interment will follow the service at Crumpton Cemetery in Crumpton Md.
