



## Patricia "Pat" A. Patterson Scott

January 24, 1942 - March 30, 2024

Patricia "Pat" A. Patterson Scott of Church Hill, MD passed away on March 30, 2024. She was 82 years old.

She was born in Long Branch, NJ on January 24, 1942, the daughter of the late Charles R. Patterson, Jr. and Marsina Martin Patterson. The family moved to Cambridge, MD in 1949 and then near Chestertown in 1958. She graduated from Sudlersville High School with the class of 1959.

She was married first in 1960 to E.T. Kimble, with whom she had three children. They were married until 1986, she then re-married the late Lynwood Scott in 1989. For most of her adult life, she worked part-time jobs at C & P Phone Company, A & P Food Store, and as a school bus driver. In 1988, she graduated from college as a physical therapist assistant.

Pat was a member and leader in 4-H and the MD 4-H All-Stars, a life and charter member of the Sudlersville Fire Company Auxiliary, an active member of St. Luke's Parish for 44 years, and St. Paul's Kent for many years. She served on several other boards as well.

She enjoyed camping and traveling, visiting all 48 contiguous states in her lifetime. She loved visiting and entertaining family, especially large family picnics or gatherings, and researching family history.

She was preceded in death by her husband of 33 years, Lynwood B. Scott, on October 1, 2022.

She is survived by her children: E.T. "Teddy" Kimble, Jr., Patty Clark, Robert Kimble, and her step daughter: Deborah Scott; grandchildren: Robbie, Caitlyn,

Sabrina, and Cameron; great-grandchild, Will; step-grandson: Nathan Williams and brother, Charles Patterson III.

Services will be held on Friday, April 5 at 12:00 noon at St. Luke's Episcopal Church in Church Hill, MD. A visitation will be held two hours prior, from 10:00 am – 12:00 pm, at the church. Interment to follow in St. Luke's Cemetery.
