Patricia Ann "Patsy" Kenton went to be with her Lord on Friday November 18, 2011. She was 70. Born December 4, 1940 in Easton, she was the daughter of the late Norman Abram and Nora Coleman Saulsbury.

She was a member of the Denton Church of the Nazarene, where she was a Sunday School teacher for many years. In her spare time she enjoyed baking and making her peanut brittle, knitting, and spending time with her family, especially her grandchildren.

Patsy, as she was affectionately known, is survived by her husband, Robert H.
