Patricia “Patsy” Ann Schweppe passed away on December 23, 2020, at Talbot Hospice in Easton, MD. She was 89.

Born on May 1, 1931, in Cincinnati, OH, she was the daughter of the late Benjamin Stephen Skinner and Gladys Irvin Skinner. Patricia attended Clarion University in PA, graduating in 1952 with a Bachelor's of Arts degree in English. She later received her Master's degree in Speech Pathology from Trenton State University in New Jersey.

On June 23, 1954, Patricia married the love of her life, James Elliott Schweppe, Sr., in Corry, PA. After many years of teaching secondary school, she worked for 25 years as a speech therapist in the Bucks County School System in Pennsylvania, before retiring in 1990.

Patricia was an active member of Flemington Presbyterian Church, New Jersey, serving as elder, deaconess, and Sunday School teacher. She belonged to the PA State Association of Retired Teachers following her years of teaching and speech therapy. Patsy enjoyed writing, painting, traveling, playing Mahjong, and reading romance and mystery novels.

Patricia is survived by her husband, James Schweppe, Sr. “Jim”; sons, James “Jim” E. Schweppe, Jr. (Robin) of Easton, MD, and Scott C. Schweppe

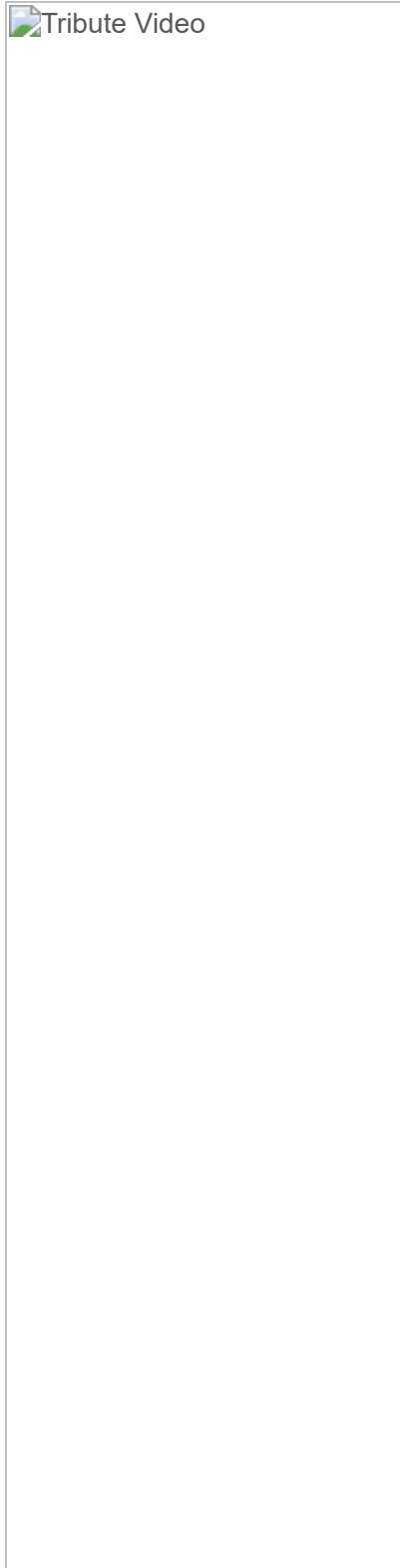
In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her brother-in-law, Robert Schweppe and his wife, Miriam.

We lost touch, and then we reconnected. By now she and Jim were living in Dover, DE. Twice I traveled there and was their house guest. I found both of them to be hospitable and two very down to earth people.
