Patricia Ann Vickers Smith of Chestertown, MD, died on October 24, 2020, at her home. She was 73.

She was born in Chestertown on January 9, 1947, the daughter of the late Sheriff Bartus O. Vickers and Virginia Porter Vickers. She was a graduate of Chestertown High School Class of 1965 and Goldey Beacom College Class of 1967. Pat worked as an administrative assistant to the President, the Dean, and most recently the registrar's office with Washington College. Her career spanned over 40 years with Washington College.

She was married to Lawrence Corey Jones for eight years before marrying Kirby Lawson Smith, III, in 1981. Pat enjoyed reading, gardening, growing flowers, driving her car, and her being with her dogs. She was most happy when entertaining her family and many friends. She was known for her kind words and endearing smile. She was a member of the Red Hat Society.

In addition to her husband, she is survived by her children, Christopher C. Jones (Julie) of Glen Arm, MD, Elizabeth Sabasteanski (Joe) of Chestertown, MD, and Kirby Virginia Smith of Waxhaw, NC; along with her grandchildren, Scout, Carter, Mackey Morgan, and Anna.

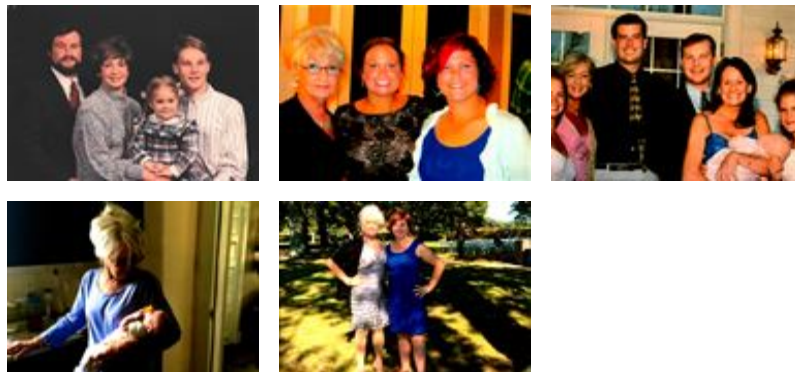

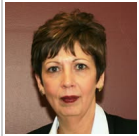
