Patricia Miller Sood passed away peacefully on August 10, 2012.

The loving wife of James Howard Sood for 52 years, Pat was the devoted mother of Cynthia (Kevin), John (Trazy) and James (Kathy). She is also survived by six grandchildren whom she adored, Laura, Kelly, Patrick, Jack, Lucy and Ellie, and many other friends and loved ones. Her brother, William D. Miller, preceded her in death.

Daughter of the late, Eugene and Olive Miller, Pat was born in Orange, NJ, on July 13, 1935. She proudly attended Allegheny College where she sang in the choir and was a member of the Kappa Kappa Gamma sorority. She taught junior high school English before marrying and starting a family. After moving to Maryland in 1966 from New Jersey, the family settled in Rockville, where Pat was a homemaker, volunteer and later a preschool teacher. From 1973-74, the family lived in Helsinki, Finland, while Pat's husband was a visiting professor of International Marketing at the Helsinki School of Economics.

Upon her husband's retirement, the couple moved to Chestertown, where they were active in many clubs and organizations. An avid reader, Pat served as president of the Women's Literary Club of Chestertown during 2006-07, and was a longtime member of the Women's League of Washington College. She loved all types of music and sang with the Chestertown Chorale, and was a

member of the Chester River Yacht and Country Club.

Pat was an accomplished gardener, a genealogy enthusiast, and loved to travel. In 1997, she and her husband, worked and taught in the Semester-at-Sea program, circling the world by ship as the students continued their college studies. Pat lived her life by the Golden Rule, and her gentle, positive, compassionate spirit will be greatly missed.
