Patricia Wilson Taylor, age 94, of Chestertown, MD, died on Monday, August 25, 2014, at home, with her family by her side.

She was the daughter of the late Edith Bradley and Robert D. Wilson. Patricia was born in Philadelphia, PA and attended Friends School there, graduating in 1938. She attended Duke University where she was president of her sorority, Kappa Alpha Theta. She graduated from Duke in 1942. She married Evans Taylor in 1944 and lived in Wallingford, PA, and Hinsdale, IL.

After spending many summers in Chestertown at Fox Point Farm, she and her family made it their permanent home. She was a homemaker and gardener. An avid Duke basketball fan, she was a close confidant of Coach K. She was an active member of St. Paul's Parish, Kent. She served as a volunteer Pink Lady at Kent and Queen Anne's Hospital. She was a regular in her bridge club that met every Wednesday.

Her husband, Evans Taylor, died in 2005. Her two sons survive her, Peter Evans Taylor (Leslie) of Scituate, MA and Michael Downing Taylor (Rebecca) of Chestertown, MD. A third son, Andrew Wilson Taylor, predeceased her, and his wife, Ruth Anne McSorley Taylor, survives. She leaves six grandchildren, Matt and Evan Taylor, Alex and Sarah Taylor, and Justin and Lisa Taylor, as well as three great-grandchildren.

A funeral service will be held Friday, August 29, at 1p.m. at St. Paul's Parish, Kent, on Sandy Bottom Road, Chestertown, MD. Interment will be private.
