Patricia Frances Wilson of Chestertown, MD died on August 8, 2012 at Chester River Hospital Center in Chestertown, MD. She was 74.

Ms. Wilson was born on October 3, 1927 in Allegany County, MD. She was the daughter of the late Edward Arthur and Stella Virginia Reckley

Taschenberger. Ms. Wilson graduated from Fort Hill High School class of 1955 and from Towson State Teachers College class of 1960. She married Stanley

Edward Wilson in 1960 and they were married for 37 years. Their marriage ended in divorce in 1997. Ms. Wilson taught school at Lutherville Elementary

School and at Kennedyville School. She retired from Kennedyville School to raise her family. She later worked as a Certified Nursing Assistant, in the area.

Ms. Wilson enjoyed birding and spending as much time as possible with her grandchildren. She was a member of the Kent County Ornithological Society and a devoted member of Christ United Methodist Church.

Ms. Wilson is survived by her daughter, Kelly W. Jester and husband Richard of Bel Air, MD, a sister; Yvonne Robbins of Ft. Walton Beach, FL and three grandchildren; Madelyn, Abigail and Luke Jester.
