Patricia Carreau Wrightson of Easton, MD died March 15, 2005.

She was born November 11, 1917 in Bedford, PA to the late Mary Louise Stiver and John Raymond Burke. During the later part of her childhood, she was raised and adopted by her late aunt and uncle, Margaret Stiver Carreau and Robert Carreau.

Pat was a resident for the last eight years at William Hill Manor, having suffered a stroke in July 1997. She grew up in Bedford, PA and attended St. Lawrence University.
