Patrick Cooper Redmond (56) passed away on December 22, 2025 at University of Maryland Shore Medical Center at Easton. 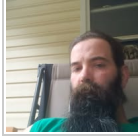

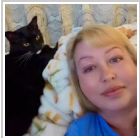
