Patrick C. Homentowski of Crumpton, MD died on Wednesday, July 2, 2003 at Kent & Queen Anne's Hospital, Chestertown, MD. He was 89.

Born in Riverside, NJ on February 23, 1914, he was the son of the late Joseph and Josephine Homentowski.

During World War II he served in the Army Air Corp as a Tail Gunner and was in the Normandy France Rhineland American Theater. Among his many honors he was decorated with 3 Bronze Stars, the Air Medal with one Oak Leaf Cluster, good conduct medal and wings. Pat was held prisoner of war for 8 months. He flew in 14 combat missions in a B-24 aircraft over occupied territory of Germany and France.

Pat enjoyed the outdoors and was quite a specialist painter and sign maker. He also loved and enjoyed the family pet, Toby.

Mr. Homentowski is survived by and lived with his loving caregiver, his niece, Josephine Illingsworth & her husband Robert E. Illingsworth, Sr. of Millington, MD. He is also survived by several nieces, nephews and many great nieces and nephews.
