Patrick Kelly Mullikin died on February 7, 2011. He was 46.

Born in Easton on April 9, 1964, he was the son of Ginny Sherwood Turkington of Easton and Lulu Mullikin of Easton. He graduated from Easton High School in 1982. After graduation, he entered the U. S. Navy, where he served until being honorably discharged in 1986. He then split his professional time between Bolton Farm and P.K. Painting.

He was an avid sports fan and especially loved watching the Chicago Bears. He enjoyed hunting and playing golf and softball.
