Paul Bruce Burton of Grasonville, MD, died suddenly at Memorial Hospital, in Easton, MD, on Tuesday, March 1, 2005. He was 52.

Born July 6, 1952, in Baltimore, MD, he was the son of Virginia Borowiak and the late, S. Dixon Burton. He was a graduate of Mergenthaler Vo/Tech School. He later obtained his pilot aviator license and worked for Butler Airways and Freeway Airport as a mechanic.
