



Paul Irving Gildersleeve

August 14, 1928 - November 28, 2011

Paul Irving Gildersleeve of Chestertown, Maryland, died on Monday November 28, 2011, at University of Maryland Medical Center in Baltimore. He was 83.

Mr. Gildersleeve was born in Poughkeepsie, NY, on August 14, 1928, the son of the late Edith Vincent Fogden Gildersleeve and Irving Gildersleeve. He graduated from Arlington High School in Poughkeepsie, with the Class of 1946. In 1950, he married Susan Metcalf. They were married for seven years.

He owned and operated Game Harbor Farm, and in 1960, remarried to Marian Simperts Thomas. They were married for 13 years. After he sold his farm, he took a position as superintendent with Chester River Yacht and Country Club. Mr. Gildersleeve later worked as the superintendent with Cove Creek Country Club in Stevensville, MD, and later in 1986 with Blue Heron Golf Course from which he retired in 1998.

He was a former member of Emmanuel Episcopal Church in Chestertown and was a member of Chester River Yacht and Country Club from 1951 until 2005. Mr. Gildersleeve loved golf, hunting, fishing, gardening, waterskiing, and boating on the Chester River.

He is survived by his nieces, Stephenie Fogden of New Platz, NY, Katherine Fogden of Alexandria, VA; his nephew, David Fogden of Tillson, NY; great-

nieces Julie, Jade, and Josette; and his sister-in-law, Gloria Fogden. He is also survived by his dear friends, Lavina, Mary and Ken, and Dona along with his former wife Marian's children.

He was preceded in death by his parents and his brother, Peter Fogden.

Services will be held on Saturday, January 14, 2012, at 12 p.m. at Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, Chestertown, MD. Interment will be in St. Paul's Cemetery.
