Paul William “Bill” Marshall died at Heron Point, Chestertown, Maryland on August 17, 2007. He was 86.

Bill and his wife of 63 years, Eileen, lived virtually all of their lives in Chester and Montgomery counties in Pennsylvania until retiring to the Eastern Shore of Maryland fourteen years ago. It was there that Bill realized his lifelong wish to be on the water. He spent most days in spring, summer and fall sailing his small day-sailer or working with the Coast Guard Auxiliary.

An engineer by profession, he received national and international awards in the areas of die-casting and robotics. Most of his professional life was spent with the Doehler Jarvis Corporation (later NL Industries) in Pottstown, PA, where he rose to be plant manager. Upon retirement he started his own engineering consulting firm, EMAR Corporation, with clients in the US, Europe, and Asia.

Bill received his B.S. in engineering from Lehigh University in 1942. He was an engineering officer on the US Merchant Marine in WWII. He subsequently earned a MBA in Operations Research at Drexel University.

Besides his wife, Mr. Marshall is also survived by a son, Paul Marshall of Sudbury, MA; three grandchildren, Bridget of Lowell, MA, Elizabeth of

Wellington, NZ, and Brendan of Germantown, MD. He is predeceased by his son, Bill Marshall of Carlisle, PA.
