Paul Louis Schwartz, 76, of St. Michaels MD, passed away on Wednesday October 21, 2015, at Bayleigh Chase (William Hill Manor) in Easton after a long battle with cancer. Born on August 15, 1939, in Washington DC, he was the son of the late Louis and Dorothy Schwartz of Landover Hills, MD.

Paul grew up in Landover Hills, raised his family in Lanham, MD, and retired in St. Michaels MD. Paul worked in commercial construction as an insulator for over 30 years before retiring in 2001.
