Paul Clifford Wentzell of Stafford, VA, formerly of Chester, MD., died on August 26, 2016, at Stafford Hospital. He was 94.

Born April 6, 1922, in New Jersey, he was the only child of the late Mr. Clifford Wentzell and Mrs. Rhoda Wentzell.

Mr. Wentzell graduated from Nation Bridgeton High School in 1940. He is a WWII Veteran and served in the United States Army from 1942 – 1945 in Africa, the Middle East, and European countries. He married Mary Ruth Hampton, and they made their home in St. Mary's County, MD. Paul began his career with DNR as an Officer where he retired as a Lt. Col. after 33 years. He later married Cordelia Wentzell with whom he also resided in St. Mary's County. Then on January 1, 1989, he married Margarita Wentzell with whom he lived in Chester, MD. He was passionate about trains and owned a Lionel train set over 80 years old, among other sets. He loved reading, cutting the grass, oil painting for a while, kite flying, stained glass work, crabbing, fishing and spending time with his granddaughters.

He is survived by his loving wife, Margarita Wentzell; his stepchildren, Ro Parra' of Austin, TX, Cearia Buehler of Stafford, VA, Sandra Ford of Crownsville, MD; and six grandchildren, Liz, Lauren, Natalie, Megan, Alison and Madison. He was preceded by his wives, Mary and Cordelia.

A funeral liturgy will be celebrated at 1:00 PM on Saturday September 3, 2016 at St. Christopher's Church in Chester, MD. Friends and family may visit on Saturday from 11:00 AM to 12:30 PM at the Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A. in Chester. Burial will follow the service at St. Peter's Catholic Cemetery, Queenstown, MD.
