Paul Edward Garrett, a lifelong resident of Talbot County, died on Wednesday, March 30, 2005 at William Hill Manor, Easton. He was 89.

Born October 22, 1915, he was the son of the late Paul Leo and Bessie E. Spencer Garrett. A lifelong farmer in Talbot County, he farmed at Wye House Farms for forty-six years until his retirement in 1994.

Mr. Garrett's wife, the former Julia C. Dulin, whom he married June 28, 1941, died October 28, 1995.

A lifetime member of the Tuckahoe Gas & Steam Association, he was also a member of the Talbot County Farm Bureau, the Antique Car Club of Talbot County, the Talbot County Corn Club, and was a longtime display exhibitor of live waterfowl at the Waterfowl Festival. He was an avid hunter and gardener and enjoyed antique tractors and cars.

Mr. Garrett is survived by five children, Spencer L. Garrett of Chantilly, VA, George Edward Garrett of Gaithersburg, MD, Mary Lou Macdonald, Paul S. Garrett and Robert L. Garrett, all of Easton; a sister, Helen Harrison of Bozman; and six grandchildren. He was predeceased by one sister and five brothers.

Services will be held on Monday, April 4, 2005 at 10:00 AM at Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., Easton where friends may call on Sunday evening from 6 to 8 PM.
