January 16, 1914 - September 22, 2011

Pauline Larrimore Truitt Cooper of Easton passed away on Thursday, September 22, 2011 at The Gardens Assisted Living in Easton. She was 97. Born January 16, 1914 on Wye Island in Queen Anne's County, she was the daughter of the late Robert Russell Larrimore and Nellie Elizabeth (Usilton) Larrimore.

Born into a farming family, Mrs. Cooper lived in a number of places with her family while growing up, including Wye Island, Skipton, Hayden (near Price), and Queenstown. She graduated from Cordova High School. In 1933 she married Henry Sparks Truitt Sr., at which time they moved to Stoney Ridge Farm near Easton and engaged in farming. In 1939 they moved to Richbottom Farm near Easton, where they continued farming and raised their family. They later made their home on a farm in Queenstown. Mr. Truitt passed away in 1965. Mrs. Cooper later married Ezekiel Fox Cooper. They lived in Baltimore until Mr. Cooper's death in 1971. Pauline returned to live in Cordova, and always felt fortunate to have family living near her. Mrs. Cooper grew up around a large extended family. She always enjoyed visiting and keeping in touch with them. She served as a 4-H Leader, a member of the Homemakers Club, and enjoyed cooking, sewing, and quilting.

Mrs. Cooper is survived by her daughter, Anne Truitt Heinsohn and her husband Harry of Cordova; a sister, Mary E. Rice of Easton; nine grandchildren: Phil Truitt and his wife Betsy, Mike Truitt and his wife Sharon,
