Pauline Thom Morgan, of Easton, MD, died Sunday evening, December 2, 2012, at Genesis Healthcare-The Pines, in Easton. She was 88.

Born on June 29, 1924, she was the daughter of the late Paul and Agnes Thom, of Easton. She graduated from Easton High School and married Edgar Allen Morgan, of Queen Anne, on May 15, 1941. Her husband preceded her in death on October 13, 1990.
