A Funeral Liturgy for Pauline Stefano, of Easton, will be celebrated at Saints Peter & Paul Catholic Church, Easton, on Wednesday, October 30, 2002 at 11 A.M.

Mrs. Stefano died at the Dorchester General Hospital, Cambridge, on Saturday, October 26, 2002. She was 74.

Born in Montalbano Elicona, Italy, June 26, 1928, she was the daughter of the late Salvatore and Antonina Mobilia Russo. After completing her education, she taught in an elementary school for the next seven years. On June 8, 1957, she married Salvatore Stefano in Tindari, Italy. In 1960, they moved to Easton, MD where they operated Stefano's Sub Shop on Route 50 for the next 30 years.

A member of Saints Peter and Paul Catholic Church in Easton, her hobbies included crocheting and needlework.

Surviving, in addition to her husband, are a daughter, Antonella Carlo of Brookfield, CT; a son, Tommy Stefano of Easton, two brothers, Angelo Russo and Vincenzo Russo, both of Redcliffe Queensland, Australia and two grandchildren, Arianna Carlo and Paula Stefano.

Burial will be at Spring Hill Cemetery, Easton.
