Paul Johnson Heister of Easton, MD, formerly of Oxford died on Friday, October 15, 2004 at Talbot Hospice House, Easton. He was 91.

Born in Washington D.C., on March 21, 1913, he was the son of the late Michael and Stella Willeke Heister. He graduated from Central High School in Washington D.C. in 1932. In 1943 he enlisted in the United States Navy where he served with the Pacific Theater of Operations during WW II until his Honorable Discharge in 1946. On May 21, 1949 he married Claire C. Jachimowicz in Larksville, PA. Mr. Heister began a career as Boat Captain for the U.S. Bureau of Commercial Fisheries, now known as N.O.A.A. Following his retirement, he became an avid boat builder.

A lifetime member of the Oxford Volunteer Fire Department, he was also a member of the Bay Country Chorus.

In addition to his wife, Mr. Heister is survived by a son, Michael Heister of Greenwood Lake, NY; two daughters, Christina Driscoll of Crofton, Maryland and Mary-Angela Martin of Greensboro, MD; a brother, Albert Joseph Heister of Vero Beach, FL; a sister, Stella Adelaide Heister of Washington, D.C.; six grandchildren, Matthew Driscoll, Joshua Driscoll, Max Martin, Sam Martin, Luke Martin and Julia Martin. Two brothers and two sisters are deceased.

Graveside services will be held on Thursday, October 21, 2004 at 11:00 a.m. at Oxford Cemetery, Oxford, MD.
