



Paul W. Satterfield, Sr.

May 13, 1927 - October 26, 2008

Paul Watson Satterfield, Sr. of Easton, MD died on Sunday, October 26, 2008 at Genesis Healthcare – The Pines, Easton, MD. He was 81.

Born May 13, 1927 in Denton, MD, he was the son of the late Edwin G. and Ethel Watson Satterfield. He attended Caroline Public School in Ridgely, MD. Prior to moving to Easton in 1999, he lived in Caroline County where he worked as a dairy farmer until retiring in 1993.

His first wife of forty-two years, the former Mary Ida Rampmeyer, died April 3, 1991. In 1999 he married Charlotte H. George.

He was a member of the Caroline County Farm Bureau, Caroline County Historical Society, the Model A Car Club, the Gold Ballroom Dance Club, and past member of Dairy Farmers of America. He served as chaplain of the E.E. Streets Memorial Post V.F.W. Men's Auxiliary, and was a member of American Legion Post #71 in Cambridge, B.P.O. Easton Elks Lodge #1622, and Easton Moose Lodge #1520.

In addition to his wife, Mr. Satterfield is survived by four children, Carolyn Garrett and her husband Jeffery of Ridgely, Nancy Gearhart and her husband Toby of Ridgely, Paul "Buddy" Satterfield, Jr. and his wife Cheryl of Ridgely, and Edwin Satterfield and friend Sheila of Denton; one sister, Barbara

Bennington of Ridgely; eight grandchildren, Miles and Molly Garrett, Kyle, Samantha, and Cody Satterfield, Abigail Gearhart, and Chelsey and Evelyn Satterfield; one great-grandchild, Holland Garrett; and three step-children, Sister Beth, Michael Daddio, and Scott Gannon. He was predeceased by two brothers, Robert and Burton Satterfield.
