Paul Woodrow Wilson Myers of Chestertown, Md. died on Saturday October 20, 2001 at Magnolia Hall Nursing Home. He was 87.

Born in Opossum Hollow in Worton, Maryland on July 4, 1914, he was the son of the late Carl Paul and Margaret Ann Frances Younger Myers. After graduating from Chestertown High School class of 1932.

Mr. Myers was a farmer with C.K. Dulin for several years. He married Ethel Elizabeth Carroll on June 6, 1945. Mr. Myers then went to work with Massey Ferguson as a mechanic, traveling for many years. He then worked in the same capacity with Kingstown Tractor in Chestertown, Md. and retired in 1983.
