



## Pearl Haussler

April 4, 1917 - April 16, 2011

Pearl Haussler of Annapolis, Maryland passed away unexpectedly at Anne Arundel Medical Center surrounded by her loving family on April 16, 2011. She was 94 years old.

Born on April 4, 1917 in Bronx, New York she was the daughter of the late Charles and Sophia Bieniewicz Woska. Pearl worked with Security National Bank, Long Island NY and later with Mater Dei Nursing Home, Elmer, NJ.
