Pearl B. Dressel of Easton, MD died on Monday, September 20, 2004 at Genesis Eldercare-The Pines, Easton. She was 84.

Born January 31, 1920 in Troy, New York, she was the daughter of the late Robert E. and Kathleen Warnock Bradley. She was a 1938 graduate of Central High School in Washington, D.C. From 1957 to 1970, she worked as a secretary for Standard Brands, Inc., and in 1971 became Clerk of the Circuit Court in Annapolis, MD where she remained until her retirement in 1981.

Her husband, Wilfred C. Dressel, whom she married in July 1970, died March 31, 1989.

A resident of Easton since 1985, she was a member of Trinity Cathedral. Following the death of Mr. Dressel, she helped establish an Alzheimer's support group at William Hill Manor in Easton.

Mrs. Dressel is survived by three children, Kathleen Wanner and her husband, Ron of Easton, MD, Albert Simmons, Jr. and his wife, Sue of Channelview, Texas, and Roy Simmons and his wife, Sally of Clifton Forge, VA; seven grandchildren and fourteen great grandchild. Her first husband, Albert Simmons and her brother, Robert Bradley, Jr. are deceased.
