Peggy Sue Baker (Emerson), 83, of Selbyville, DE, passed away peacefully on May 7, 2019, at her daughter's home in Centreville, MD, surrounded by family.

Peggy was born December 15, 1935 to George B Emerson and Mary Pauline Emerson (Johnson) in Concord, NC. She was the last of five daughters, which gave her the nicknames Babe/Baby.
