Peggy June (Edwards) Buettner of Centreville, MD, died on December 13, 2020, at Compass Regional Hospice House with her husband, William Buettner, Sr., at her side.

She was born in Greensboro, NC, on March 17, 1935, the daughter of the late Wilbur and Nell Edwards.

She attended Glen Burnie High School and married her husband in 1952. They lived in Ferndale and then Glen Burnie, MD, raising seven children together. In addition to being a homemaker and loving mother and wife for 68 years, Peggy taught art at Martin Spalding High School and worked for St. Louis Parish in Clarksville.

She was predeceased by her parents; her brother, George Edwards; and her daughter, Robin Shaw of Berlin, MD.

Peggy is survived by her children, Karin Grasso, Cassandra Forcucci, René Kratzke, William Buettner, Jr., Mary Styron, and John Buettner; 10 grandchildren; and two great-granddaughters.
