On July 20, 2001 Peggy Lee Sisler died at John Hopkins's Hospital in Baltimore after a long illness. She was 75 years old. Mrs. Sisler was born on Sept 7, 1925 in Easton Md. the daughter of Thomas O'Donnell and Anna Elizabeth Horney O'Donnell. Both now deceased. She was raised in Grasonville MD where she attended school. Mrs. Sisler moved to Baltimore MD during WW2 to help with the war effort. She worked at Armco Steel. In 1944 she married Leo Elwood Sisler of Garrett County MD. They made their home in Baltimore County. Her husband died January 4, 1971. Mrs. Sisler then returned to Grasonville MD and latter to Denton MD. She was very active in the Grasonville Seventh Day Adventist Church. She would help with many of the social programs including food baskets, gathering clothing and toys. In addition she delivering them to either the Wesleyan Center, or the Crisis center both in Denton MD.

She is survived by four daughters: Phyllis Jones of Denton MD, Nancy Freels of Baltimore. MD, Margaret Baker of Greensboro MD, Bonnie Davidson of Denton MD.
