Easton: Pendleton L. "Woody" Woodson died on Wednesday, October 5, 2011 at the Memorial Hospital at Easton. He was 92. Born on May 1, 1919 in Washington, D.C. he was the son of the late Pendleton Nelson and Lisler Geraldine Lambert Woodson. After attending Woodward High School and graduating in the class of 1937, he continued his education at Columbia Technical Institute until 1942 when he enlisted in the U.S. Army. In 1946, he was honorably discharged and began working at the Pentagon on the Manhattan Project. He later began working with the Atomic Energy Commission in 1960 where he was employed as an illustrator, making charts for the A.E.C. facilities until retiring in 1974.

In 1949, he married Thelma M. "Dolly" Brown and resided in Silver Spring, MD. They later moved to Kent Island, where she passed in 1978. In 1980, he married Edna Kinnman and moved to Easton in 1981. She later passed in 1990. On May 17, 1999, he married Mary E. Grimes Sullivan and resided in Easton.

Mr. Woodson was a member of the Antique Auto Club, American Legion Pentagon Post #62, and the YMCA.

In addition to his wife, Mary, he is survived by Heather Ewing Daffin, whom he cherished like a daughter. Mr. Woodson had a very special love for dogs.
