Penelope "Penny" Mullikin McNeal, formerly a resident of Talbot and Caroline counties died on Thursday, October 27, 2005 at Dorchester General Hospital. She was 91.

Born in Talbot county, December 15, 1913, she was the daughter of the late James Thomas and Lillian Larrimore Mullikin. She was a resident of Talbot county all of her life until moving to Preston in the mid 1990's. For the last two years, she has been a resident of Mallard Bay Nursing and Rehab Facility in Cambridge. In her lifetime, she was a seamstress and worked on a farm. In 1936, she married Edward Rufus McNeal. Mr. McNeal died in January 1975.

Mrs. McNeal was a member of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints in Cambridge, where she was a former greeter, past secretary of the relief society and a primary teacher as well as a visiting teacher.
