



## Penny M. Dietz

September 27, 1945 - November 26, 2010

Penny M. Dietz died at home on November 26, 2010. She was 65 years old.

Born in Pittsburgh, PA on September 27, 1945, she was the daughter of Commander Homer A. Morrow of Easton and the former Maxine Kennison Morrow. Growing up, she lived on various Naval Stations. She followed in the footsteps of her father and two sisters by attending Park College in Parkville, MO. On May 19, 1973, she married her husband, Peter M. Dietz in New York City. She worked in the office of Tidewater Physical Therapy in Easton for 12 years.

Mrs. Dietz was a member of the Tred Avon Yacht Club. An avid bridge player, she was a member of the Wednesday Night Bridge Club Ladies for 30 years. In addition, she played in various charitable bridge groups and the Tred Avon Yacht Club group. She loved boating, traveling, sewing, gardening and making Christmas ornaments for her family and friends.

Penny was a firm believer in the Waterfowl Festival mission. She was a Director for 8 years, was a recipient of the Waterfowl Festival Service Award in 1993 and 1995, a member of the Art Committee for many years and elected to the Hall of Fame in 2001. She co-chaired the Gold Room Art Gallery for 13 years. In addition, Penny started and co-chaired the Collectors Gallery, which was the forerunner to the Masters Gallery, for 2 years.

She attended St. Peter and Paul Catholic Church in Easton.

She is survived by her husband, Peter M. Dietz of Easton; her father, Homer A. Morrow of Easton; her son, Peter Michael Dietz of Easton; and her sisters, Kathy Boyer and Linda Morrow, both of Indianapolis, IN.

A memorial service will be held at 3:00 pm on Thursday, December 2 at St. Mark's United Methodist Church in Easton.

A public gathering following the service will be held at the Tred Avon Yacht Club in Oxford.
